MAMA MADE ME

SUMMER TODDLER DRESS: FITS MOST SIZES 18 TO 2T

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

1/2-YARD FABRIC

COORDINATING THREAD

2 BUTTONS

BUTTON HOLE FOOT FOR SEWING MACHINE

PINKING SHEARS

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Wash and press fabric**
- 2. Cut pattern along dotted scissor line and tape together, matching letters as a guide. TIP: When taping together pattern, leave one pattern side uncut. This will make it easier to tape pieces together by allowing a border for tape to adhere.**
- 2. Lay fabric on floor, right side down. Fold one selvedge side to middle, fold other selvedge side to meet in middle. This will create two folded edges (one on right side, one on left side) for your pattern. Smooth out any wrinkles before pinning pattern.**
- 3. Pin pattern to folded, smoothed fabric. Cut out pattern with fabric scissors.**
- 4. Use pinking shears to cut along bottom edge of Front and Back lining. ALT: fold and finish hem.**
- 5. With right sides together, sew Front and Front lining together, leaving dress sides and bottom (and Front Lining pinked edge) open. Use a 1/2" seam allowance.**
- 6. Repeat step 5 with Back and Back lining.**
- 7. Trim seam allowances on Front and Back. Snip strap corner seam allowances to reduce bulk.**
- 8. Turn right sides out and iron flat.**
- 9. Right sides together, pin Front and Back and sew along bottom of armhole to hem.**
- 10. Press open seams and turn right side out.**
- 11. Pin hem to desired length and sew.**
- 12. Mark buttonholes with water-soluble pen on Back (1/2" above edge of straps when Back straps are folded over onto Front)**
- 13. Using buttonhole foot, make buttonholes on Back Straps. TIP: When cutting open buttonhole with seam ripper, place pin across buttonhole ends as guard. This way, you lose the risk of cutting through your buttonhole border.**
- 14. Sew buttons on Front where buttonhole on straps meet.**
- 15. Voila! Done! Enjoy! If you like, share pics of your project!! I love to see what you create! Xx**

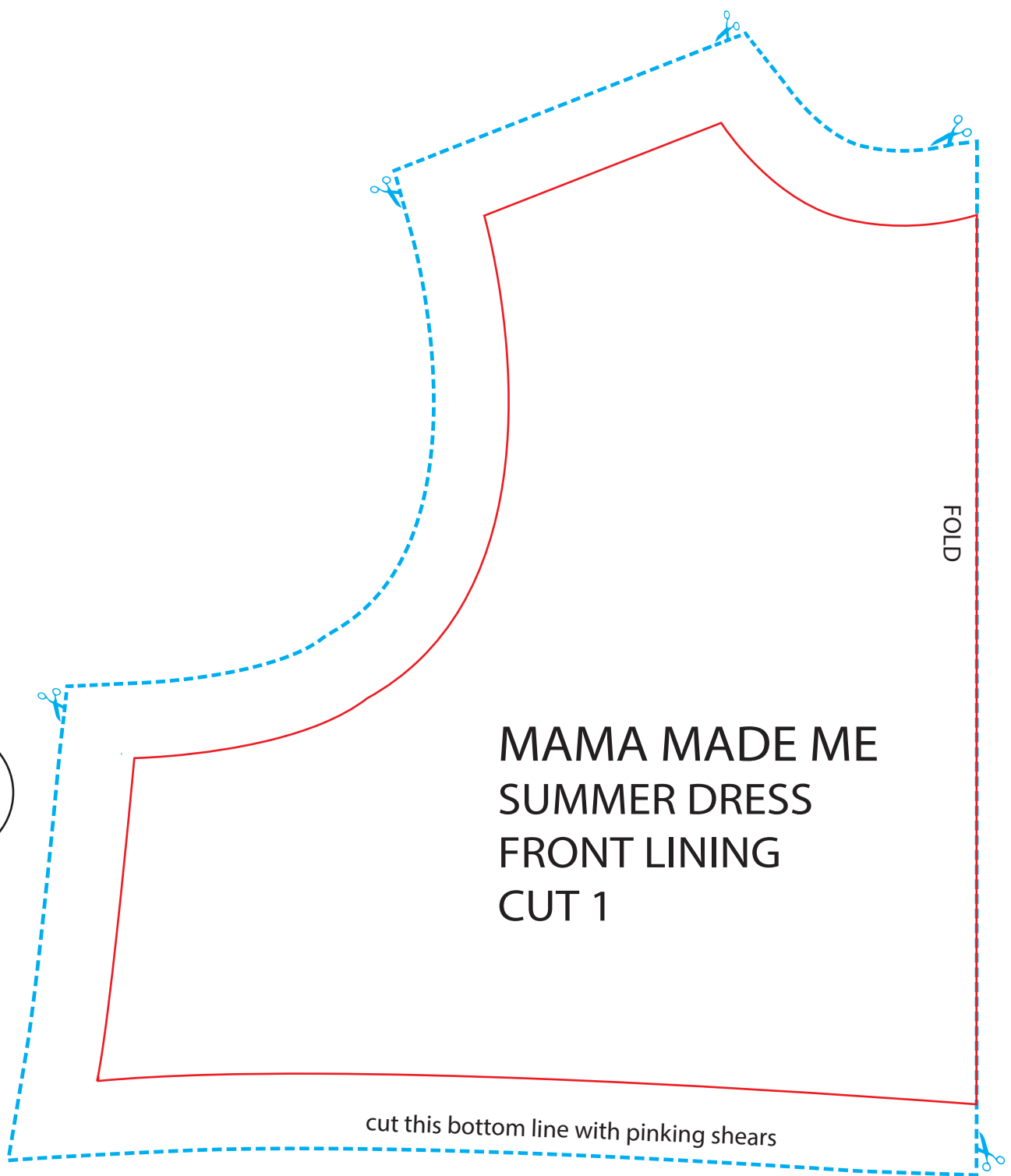

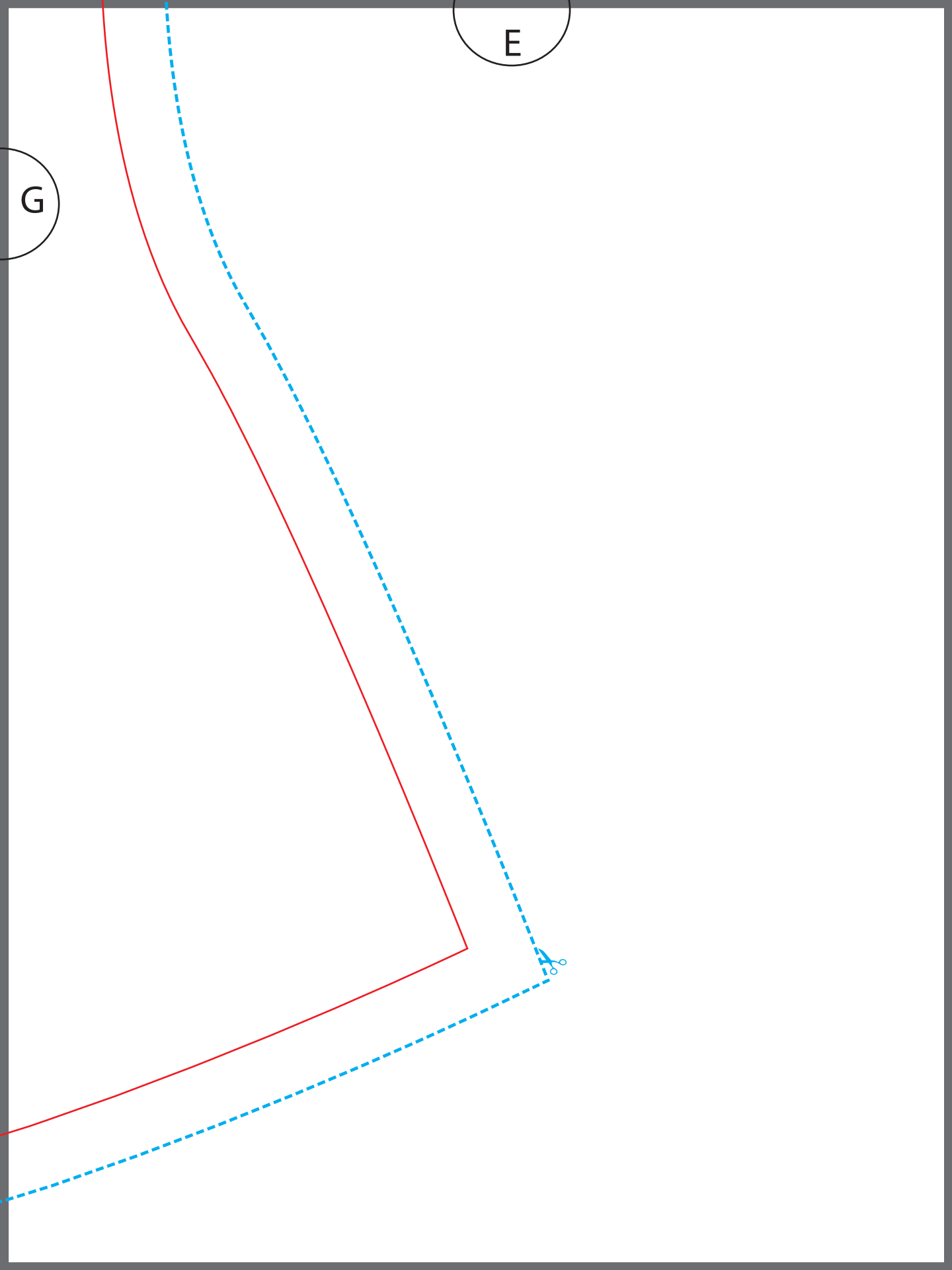
